

#### DAYS 1-2 : MIAMI : HAVANA

Next, visit the famous Callejón de Hamel, an outdoor haven for Afro-Cuban musicians and artists in Centro Habana. At the end of the day, we'll check in to our hotel in the heart of Havana. Orientation with your insightCuba tour leader and welcome dinner at El Templete will follow. Meals Day 1 | Enjoy dinner on your own, at your leisure Meals Day 2 | Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

#### DAY 3 : HAVANA

After breakfast, we'll hear a lecture by an expert on contemporary Cuba. Guests will be encouraged to ask their most pressing questions. Visit an interactive community project devoted to traditional embroidery and other handicrafts. You'll also enjoy the rare chance to see a Santeria religious dance demonstration. After this, you'll visit the Finca "La Yoandra," an organic farm that also provides after-school programs and community inspiration. The variety of fruits and vegetables will spoil you! We'll continue our organic theme with lunch at the farm's own paladar, Il Divino, where many of their fresh fruits and vegetables are served. Next, we'll meet the dynamic artists and musicians of Muraleando, one of Havana's groundbreaking projects, where artists converted an old water tank into an art-and-performance space. Lastly, meet university students and business professionals for candid discussions about daily Cuban life. Dinner tonight will be at the famed El Aljibe. Meals | Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

#### DAY 4 HAVANA

En route to one of Cuba's renowned photography organizations, Fototeca, we'll stop to take in the colonial splendor of Old Havana: its cobblestone streets, and stunning architecture. For lunch, we'll indulge at Sloppy Joe's, where yesteryear's movie stars and baseball heroes gathered. After lunch, we'll meet with the local artists at the Casa Taller Antonia Eiriz, a house-turned-museum. Next, we'll visit Ernest Hemingway's home, Finca Vigía, where you may come to understand why the author chose to spend twenty years in Cuba. Dinner tonight is on your own. Your tour leader will be happy to recommend the best local paladares. Meals | Breakfast, Lunch



#### DAY 5 : HAVANA : PINAR DEL RÍO

After breakfast, we'll leave Havana to begin a beautiful journey to the western province of Pinar del Río. Along the way, we'll stop for a visit at the Patio de Pelegrin community project, an organic farm, art space and coffee shop. There, we'll enjoy a lunch prepared by community residents. Next, we'll meet a curator at a popular artist's home and studio to learn about his artwork, displayed in galleries in the US and museums in Cuba. After checking in at the hotel, we'll meet with the members of a remarkable opera-and-theatre group, who perform around the world. Dinner tonight will be at paladar Café Ortuzar.

#### DAY 6 : PINAR DEL RÍO : VIÑALES VALLEY

On your second day in Pinar del Río, we'll depart for the Viñales National Park to meet a local guide. At a tobacco-drying house, a tobacco farmer will teach you how to roll cigars. For lunch, you'll walk through a carved cave to reach El Palenque de los Cimarrones, where traditional Afro-Cuban music will be playing. After a savory smoked pork lunch, we'll wander into Viñales Valley, Cuba's Yosemitelike habitat, and into the town of Viñales. You'll walk on clay and admire up-close the giant limestone rocks that make the valley famous. At the end of the day, treat yourself to a refreshing coco loco (honey, rum and coconut water). You won't be disappointed! Dinner tonight is on your own.

Meals | Breakfast, Lunch

#### DAY 7 : PINAR DEL RÍO : LAS TERRAZAS : HAVANA

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll check out, then visit a cigar factory in Pinar del Río, where you'll see firsthand how these legendary cigars are made. # WHAT ARE THE TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS FOR AMERICANS?

Since the introduction of travel restrictions as part of the US Embargo against Cuba in 1963, travel to Cuba for American citizens has been highly regulated. On December 17, 2014, President Obama loosened some of these restrictions. Traveling to Cuba as an individual for tourism or a beach vacation is still prohibited. The most accepted way for Americans to visit Cuba legally is through people-to-people tours, authorized by the US Department of the Treasury, Office of Foreign Assets Control. Registering for one of our Signature or Specialty Cuba tours ensures that your travel is 100% legal, and will allow you to discover this island nation in ways never before possible.

### WHAT IS PEOPLE-TO-PEOPLE TRAVEL?

People-to-people travel is an authorized way to see Cuba while fostering connections with the Cuban people. But it's so much more.

Travelers consistently tell us that their favorite travel experiences are the connections they forge with local people. They're ours, too! Currently, Americans are allowed unlimited quantities of informational or educational materials, such as books, films, artwork, posters, photographs, and CDs. As of December 17, 2014, Americans are also allowed to bring back as much as \$400 worth of other goods, including up to \$100 worth of cigars and rum.




