PUBLIC CHARTER OPERATOR PARTICIPANT CONTRACT	
THIS AGREEMENT SETS FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH WE, ABC CHARTERS INC. 1125 SW 87 AVE, MIAMI, FLORIDA 33174, in return for payment of the amount indicated as the total charter price, agree to provide you this charter flight.	
RESPONSIBILITY: We, as the principal, are responsible to you for arranging the charter flight, provided however, that in the absence of negligence on our part, we are not responsible for personal injury or property damage caused by the air carrier or other suppliers of any of the services offered in connection with the charter	
RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT: Attached to this Agreement is your Reservation Form. We will confirm the reservation within 7 days after receiving the Reservation Form. If the charter flight is fully booked, we will advise you of alternate travel dates. The ticket will be issued only after the reservation is confirmed, and you must pay the full charter price when the ticket is issued. All checks, money orders, and credit card drafts must be made payable to your travel agent, who in turn must remit payment to ABC CHARTERS, INC.	
CHARTER PRICE: The charter price of _____ represents your cost for a charter flight that departs from _____ to _____, Cuba on _____ and returns from _____, Cuba to _____ on _____. US Airport taxes are included in the charter price.	
AIRCRAFT: This flight will be performed by _____, operating a _____ aircraft with _____ passenger seats. This air carrier reserves the right to substitute equivalent aircraft, if necessary.	
BAGGAGE: The air carrier allows each passenger to bring on the flight 44 pounds of baggage. Excess baggage fees for total weight of all bags after the 44lb is MIA-HAV \$2 per pound. Check baggage fee of \$20 per bag. We guarantee 2 check-in bags per person of a max weight of 70lbs per bag. For INTERNATIONAL flights, the air carrier's liability for lost or damaged bags is limited to the actual value of the baggage but not more than the amounts set forth in the Montreal Convention. Specifically, the air carrier's liability is limited to \$1,131 SDR per passenger regardless of the number of checked bags. If, however, you declare a higher value for baggage and pay an additional charge in advance , the air carrier's liability will be higher. You must submit your claim for lost or damaged baggage to the air carrier or to us within 3 days of the charter flight. Your claim must include a copy of the Baggage Check.	
SECURITY AGREEMENT: Your payment is protected by two financial security agreements that we have obtained from (1) Intercontinental Bank of Miami, 5722 SW 8 St Miami, FL 33144 and (2) Level One Bank 32991 Hamilton Court Farmington Hill, MI 48334. Unless you file a claim with us, or, if we are not available, with the Securer within 60 days after the completion of the charter, the Securer will be released from all liability to you under the security	
CANCELLATION AND REFUND: You have no right to any refund if you travel on the charter flight and are denied entry by the Cuban Authorities. If you cancel your reservation or if you fail to travel on the charter flight, your right to receive a refund is limited. If we resell your seat you will receive a full refund, less \$25 administrative fee, <u>Otherwise</u> as set forth below:	
<u>If your notice is received:</u> More than 30 days before departure: Less than 30 days before departure For any December Flights	<u>You will receive</u> Full refund No Refund – ONLY ASSOCIATED TAXES No Refund – ONLY ASSOCIATED TAXES
All requests for refunds must be sent to us in writing or by facsimile. Refunds will be made within 14 days of receipt of your notice of cancellation. We have no right to cancel the charter less than 10 days before departure except in circumstances that make it physically impossible to perform the charter trip . If this occurs, we will notify you as soon as possible but no later than the scheduled departure date. If the charter is cancelled, we will make a full refund to you within 14 days after cancellation.	
The rights and remedies made available under this contract are in addition to any other rights or remedies available under applicable law. However, we offer refunds under this contract with the express understanding that the receipt of the refund by you waives any additional remedies.	
INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS: The operation of the charter flight is subject to the Cuban government granting landing rights. If the air carrier cannot obtain landing rights, the flight will be cancelled, and a full refund will be made to you automatically.

SECTION OF THE REGULATIONS / GENERAL LICENSE THAT AUTHORIZES MY TRAVEL TO CUBA:

31 C.F.R. § 515.565(b) People-to-People travel under the auspices of an organization that sponsors such exchanges to promote people-to-people contact

31 C.F.R. § 515.565(b) People-to-People Travel

The travel-related transactions and such additional transactions as are directly incident to educational exchanges not involving academic study pursuant to a degree program – that is, people-to-people exchanges – are authorized, provided that:

- The exchanges take place under the auspices of an organization subject to U.S. jurisdiction and that sponsors such exchanges to promote people-to-people contact;
- Travel must be for the purpose of engaging, while in Cuba, in a full-time schedule of activities intended to enhance contact with the Cuban people, support civil society in Cuba, or promote the Cuban people's independence from Cuban authorities.
- Each traveler has a full-time schedule of educational exchange activities that will result in meaningful interaction between the traveler and individuals in Cuba.
- An employees, paid consultant, or agent of the sponsoring organization accompanies each group traveling to Cuba to ensure that each traveler has a full-time schedule of educational exchange activities; and
- The predominant portion of the activities engaged in by individual travelers is not with individuals or entities acting for or on behalf of certain prohibited officials of the Government of Cuba or certain members of the Cuban Communist Party.

Important:

Note 1: An organization that sponsors and organizes trips to Cuba in which travelers engage in individually selected and/or self-directed activities would not qualify for the general license.

Authorized trips are expected to be led by the sponsoring organization.

Transactions related to activities that are primarily tourist-oriented, including self-directed educational activities that are intended only for personal enrichment, are not authorized.
